Agenda Item: Unfinished Business, Item #1, Consolidated Application Funding Update

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Background: INFORMATION.

Consolidated Application (Title) funds are provided as a Federal Grant to support students identified as Socio-economically disadvantaged, Foster, Homeless, or English Language Learners. For school year 2021-22, Heritage Peak Charter School (HPCS) has been allocated \$263,000 to provide additional support to these specific students. These students are identified in our Student Information System, PowerSchool, via enrollment documents and are considered unduplicated. If a student qualifies under more than one category, that student will only be counted once (unduplicated) to determine funding models within each school or program.

In prior years, HPCS has used portions of Title funding to provide updated technology, pay for single-subject teachers, tutors, and counselors. As a result of additional federal funding (Corona Virus Relief funds, Elementary and Secondary Student Educational Relief funds, Expanded Learning Opportunity Grant, et. al), HPCS has chosen to fund tutors differently for the current school year. These funds are considered one-time, therefore may not be available in school year 2022-23. Consideration must be given to funding tutoring services in the future through a different source of revenue.

Due to the availability of these one-time grant sources, HPCS School Site Council will have the full Title Funding allocation at its disposal for school year 2021-2022.
